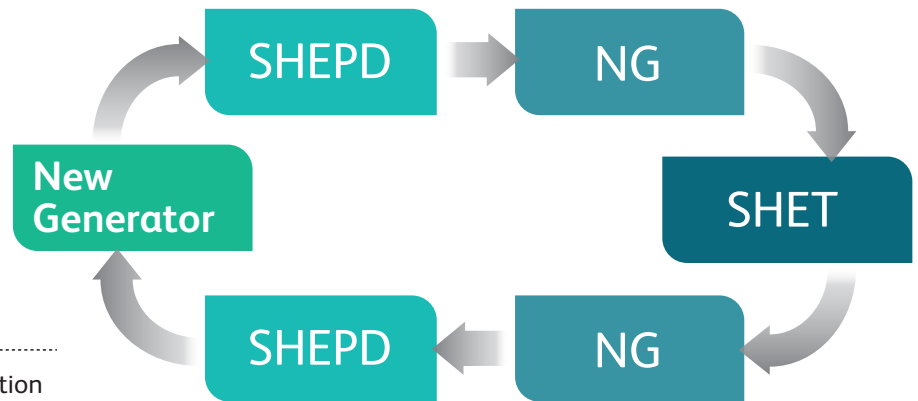


The Process of Statement of Works

The Statement of Works process (SoW) in the North of Scotland.

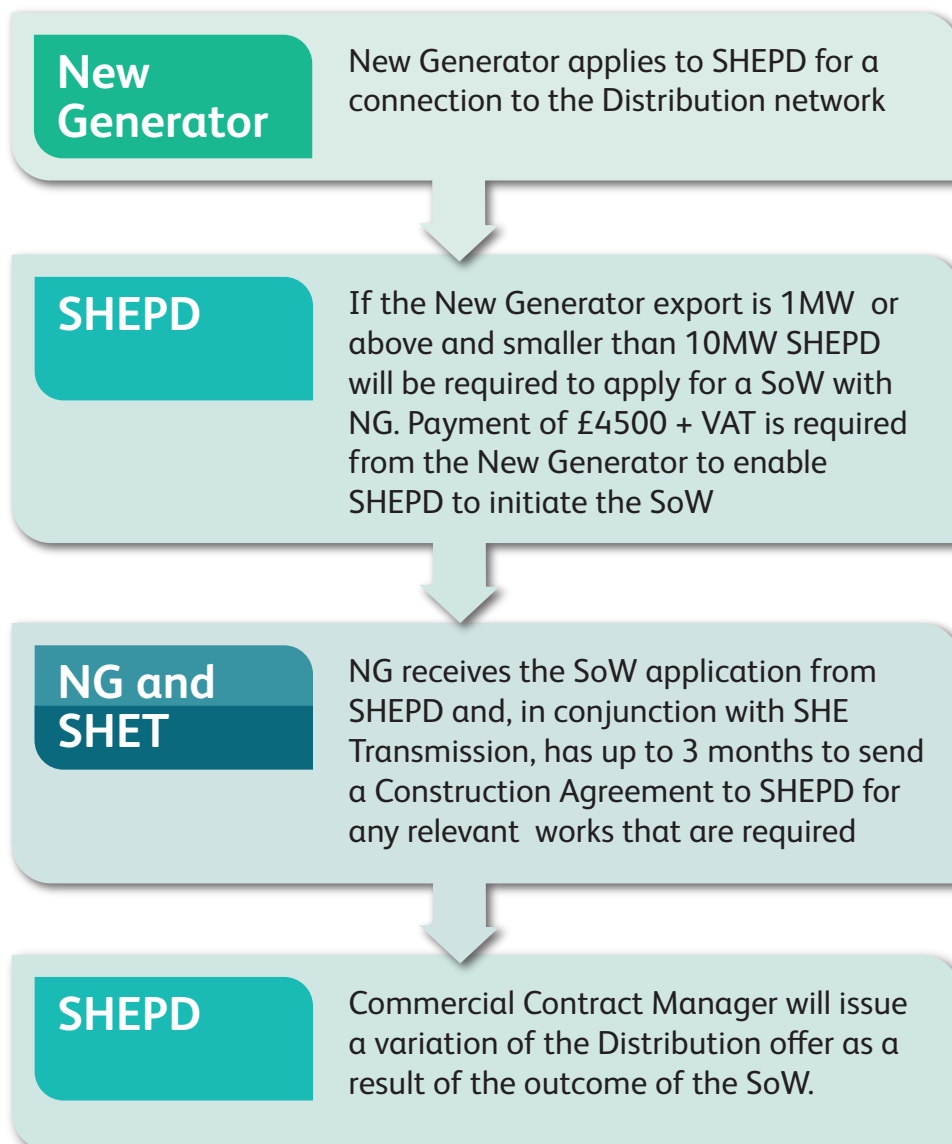
If your project is 1MW or above and smaller than 10MW we will be required to submit an application to National Grid for a Statement of Works.



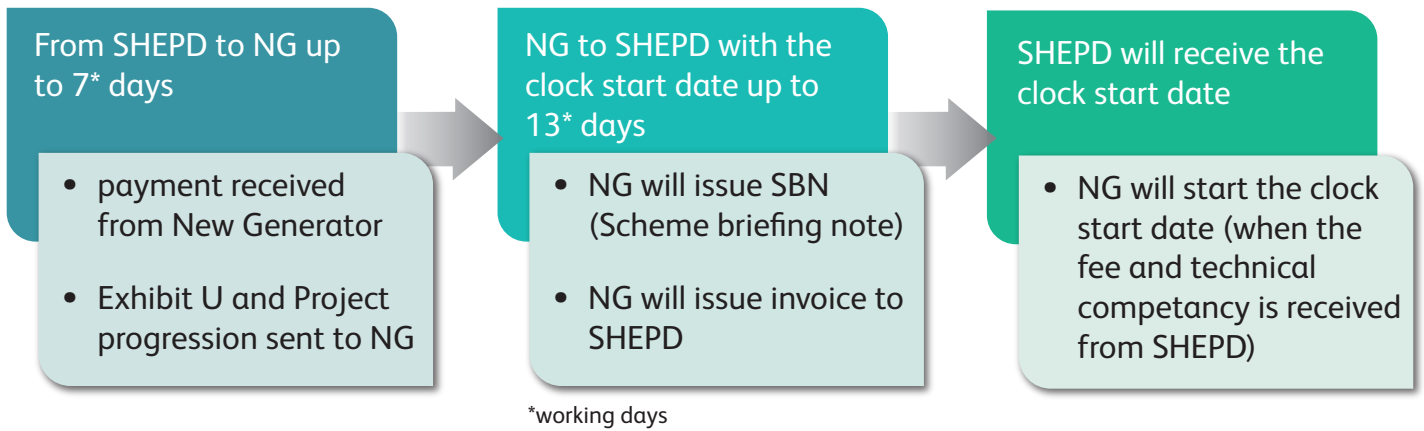
SHEPD Scottish Hydro Electric Power Distribution

When the new generator customer will be contacted

1st confirmation sent to customer

When the payment is received "Thank you for your payment in respect of ... We can confirm we have started the Statement of Works process for your generator. We will inform you of the clock start date once we receive notification from National Grid (usually within 4 weeks)"

2nd confirmation sent to customer

When the clock start is received from National Grid - we will issue a time-scale for issuing the variation "We can confirm that the clock start has been received from National Grid. We will receive the results of the Statement of Works within 3 months"

3rd confirmation sent to customer

We have received the outcome of the Statement of Works from National Grid. Your contract manager will issue you with a variation agreement within the next 2 weeks.
